Most people using a Refugee Travel Document to travel to Canada will need a visitor visa.. Exceptions: If you have a valid Canadian Refugee Travel document, you are exempt from both the visa and eTA requirements.; If you are a lawful permanent resident of the U.S. and don't have a passport, you can apply for an eTA with a valid U.S. Refugee Travel Document (I-571).

The right to apply for Refugee Travel Document after being granted refugee status also extends to the refugees' family members who are ... committed serious non-political crime in the US \* - Canada.

~~UNHCR - Note on Travel Documents for Refugees~~

A refugee travel document is valid for one year and is issued to an asylee to allow his or her return to the United States after temporary travel abroad. Can a refugee get a passport? Refugees are unlikely to be able to obtain passports from their state of nationality (from which they have sought asylum) and therefore need travel documents so that they might engage in international travel.

(b) a travel document that was issued by the country of which the foreign national is a citizen or national; (c) an identity or travel document that was issued by a country to non-national residents, refugees or stateless persons who are unable to obtain a passport or other travel document from their country of citizenship or nationality or who have no country of citizenship or nationality;

Some examples of evidence that you can submit are proof of membership in political organizations, medical or psychological reports, police reports or documents, business records, news clippings, visas, travel documents (airplane, train or bus tickets), sworn statements from witnesses, photographs, notes or recordings of threats of violence against you, or documents related to past moves.

A Refugee Travel Document can be used as a passport to travel to other countries. However, it is not the same as having a Canadian passport. Some countries which allow Canadians to enter visa-free require a visa from a sponsored person traveling with a Refugee Travel Document.

Passport Canada issues refugee travel documents and certificates of identity to protected persons in Canada. This is the case whether you are stateless or if you have citizenship from another country. Important Note: US border services have recently made changes to who may enter the US.

~~I am a refugee and I need to travel outside Canada. What ...~~

A Travel Document is a document issued by Passport Canada to those with protected status, such as Convention Refugees and other protected persons. A Certificate of Identity is for those stateless persons who are in Canada legally, but who are not refugees or other protected persons; for example, Canadian Permanent Residents who are stateless.

Adult Travel Document Application for stateless and protected persons in Canada (16 years of age or over) Information Protected Warning—Any false or misleading statement with respect to this application and any supporting document, including the concealment of any material fact, may result in the refusal to issue a Canadian travel document, the revocation of a valid Canadian travel document ...

It is your responsibility to ensure that you - and any child travelling with you - have all the valid travel documents necessary to enter in, exit from or transit through, each country/region on your itinerary. Note that the documents required for the outbound portion of your travel may differ from those required for the return. Along with the normal travel documents needed to enter Canada ...

Limitations of a refugee travel document compared to a passport. Refugee travel documents issued by the Government of Canada cannot be used for travel to the bearer's country of citizenship, and a refugee travel document issued by another country is not treated as a valid passport for the purposes of obtaining an Electronic Travel Authorization to visit Canada.

~~Which Countries Accept Refugee Travel Document? - Travel~~

Most refugees or stateless people need a visa to travel to Canada. You would still need to meet the basic requirements (and having a refugee travel document would not, in itself, disqualify you from being granted a visa): Basic travel requirements. You must meet some basic requirements to travel to Canada. You must:

Apply for a travel document in Canada - Non-Canadian adults and children Services at the Certificate of Identity Office are suspended until further notice If you submitted an application for a refugee travel document or certificate of identity, we'll process it when service returns to normal.

Such a document was provided for in the "London" Agreement relating to the issue of a travel document to refugees of 15 October 1946. 1 It was to be in booklet form in accordance with the specimen attached to the Agreement, and the period of validity of the document was to be either one or two years at the discretion of the issuing authority.

Convention Refugees Article. Holders of a blue Canadian Travel Document (Convention of July 28th, 1951) do not need a visa for transit and/or short term stay (e.g. for tourism or business purposes for up to 90 days) in Germany.

~~Apply for a travel document in Canada - Non-Canadian ...~~

You need to get a Refugee Travel Document from Passport Canada. It is recognized in all countries as a valid travel document. However, you cannot use it to travel to the country that you are a citizen of or the country of claimed persecution. If you are a: Convention refugee, or; person in need of protection, you will need a Refugee Travel ...

### ~~Convention Refugees—Federal Foreign Office~~

Every country asks for at least 6 months' validity of passport/travel document not just while applying for visa but also while travelling and returning back. So, no matter where you want to go and come back to Canada, you need to have at least 6 months' validity upon your return date. I am in the same situation as yours.

### ~~Canada Refugee Travel Document~~

Canada issues two types of travel documents: the refugee travel document and the certificate of identity. They are issued to residents of Canada who are convention refugees, protected persons, and stateless persons. They are also issued to permanent residents who can't get a national travel document for a valid reason.
