James MacGregor Burns' Theory of Transformational Leadership

James Macgregor Burns began to define the distinct nature of leadership as a separate behaviour and activity to that of management. He moved us away from talking about leaders to talking about leadership. That shift alone made people view the topic in more philosophical ways rather than the more typical mechanistic or reductionist approach.

James MacGregor Burns' treatise on leadership is the best, most influential and prominent work on leadership (Ciulla, 1995; Smith, 1995). According to Burns (1978), transforming leadership occurs when leaders engage with followers in such a way that 'leaders and followers raise one another
