Using Type 1: The conditional sentences indicate us a possible condition and its probable result. It means that the expected actions depends on a condition. If Clauses - Type 1 is used to express a possibility in the future (It is not certain that it will happen, but it is possible).

TYPE OF CONDITIONAL SENTENCES . Type 1 Open Condition: (i) If you serve me, I shall pay you. The verb in the conditional clause is in the Present Indefinite, i.e., serve and in Future Indefinite, shall pay in the main clause. The condition stated is related to the future event which may or may not take place.

In first conditional sentences, the structure is usually: if/when + present simple >> will + infinitive. It is also common to use this structure with unless , as long as, as soon as or in case instead of if .

The 4 Types of Conditionals. Conditional sentences have two clauses: a condition (if...) and a result. The verb tenses used in each clause depends on whether the speaker thinks the result is probable (real) or only exists in the imagination (unreal).
